Please can you also complete & return this to school, so that we can file it in your child's Learning Journey, thank you. These are a vital part of your child's "EYFS Profile", which we have to complete for them at the end of their time in Reception. The "Home Stories" will ask you a different thing about your child each week and they are your chance to tell us all about your special and unique child. We absolutely love reading them!



Things to remember:

- Your child has been given a purple Home/School Communication Book which should be sent into school every day in their book bag. This is to be used for messages about your child. It is **not** necessary to write in it every day.
- We do operate an open door policy and welcome communication with parents/carers. We are available at the end of most days. If necessary, an appointment can be made at a mutually convenient time for longer or more private discussions - please note, due to the current Covid 19 restrictions, these discussions would be undertaken as a telephone call.

We would appreciate:

- If you haven't already done so, please can you put **one** small key ring on the outside of your child's book bag to help them to identify it independently, thank you.

We are very much looking forward to teaching your child during their time in Reception Class.
