What have we been learning?

- In our Phonics sessions we have been learning the new digraphs **sh**, **th**, **ng** and **nk** this week. We have tried **sh**ortbread biscuits for **sh** and party ri**ng**s for **ng**. We have also been reading words (with these sounds either at the beginning or the end of words) by saying the sounds in the words and then blending them together again.
- We have been working hard recognising numbers to 20 and saying them correctly. We sometimes mix up 12 and 20 so are working hard with these numbers especially. We have also been putting these numbers into the correct order using our set of large numbers.
- ♦ We have been learning to write the number 11 correctly with the help of "Episode 11" from the "Tia Ten Show" on Ten Town. We have also been learning that the number 11 is made up of 10 and 1 more (Tia Ten and King One).
- We have been using the small world Nativity figures to help us to retell the story of the First Christmas from the Bible.

Our "**Elf Workshop**" has opened this week. We felt very important because we helped Mrs Silvester to decorate our 2x Christmas trees. We have also loved wrapping up the carboard boxes as presents and writing the gift tags independently.
