What have we been learning?

- ◆ We have been learning lots of information about different dinosaurs this week, by listening to the raps from “Andy’s Prehistoric Adventures” on CBeebies - *the link is on DB Primary if you fancy rapping along at home!*
- ◆ We used this information to help us to write some facts about a **Triceratops** independently - we remembered some very complicated facts indeed! (e.g. Did you know that Triceratops means “three-horned face” in Greek or that the “frill” around their necks acted like a kind of shield to protect them from predators?)
- ◆ In Maths this week we have been practising our counting in 1s forwards to 20 & then back again to 0, in 10s, 5s & 2s.
- ◆ In our Understanding the World sessions this week, we have been learning more about **fossils**. We enjoyed looking at some real fossils of ammonites in our Dinosaur Dig role play area.
- ◆ We have also showed our creative skills by making our own **Triceratops masks**.
