What have we been learning?

- ◆ This week we have been learning the sounds **g**, **o**, **c** and **k**. We have had a lovely time looking at many things that have these sounds in either the beginning, the middle or the end of the words. We tasted lots of delicious things too - **g**reen **g**rapes for **g**, **o**ranges for **o**, plain **c**risps for **c** and **KitKat** bites for **k**.
- ◆ In our maths sessions, we have been learning all about the 2ness of 2. We have looked at different groups of 2 objects and also the different way that 2 can be represented - as a number, on a dice, as a Numicon piece etc.
- ◆ We have been learning all about our **sense of taste** this week. We have tasted different fruits and vegetables each day as part of our snack time and we have tried hard to describe how they tasted. We came up with some wonderful adjectives such as juicy, delicious, scrumptious, hard, soft and crunchy.
- ◆ We have been continuing to learn about the Christian festival of **Harvest** in our RE sessions this week because Father Peter led our school Harvest Festival on Friday morning at St Mary's Church.

Homework

Maths - I Spy number 2 - can your child find & draw a circle around all the different ways of representing number 2?

Literacy - Help your child to look carefully at the pictures in their reading book and encourage them to tell you what's happening. Encourage them to use story language such as "Once upon a time..." or "One day..." etc. *Please try to make a comment about your child's reading every week.*

- Continue to practise recognising character names by sight.

- Recap on the sounds **g**, **o**, **c** and **k**. *Can the children identify them in their brown book? Can they think of words which contain those sounds?* Practise forming **g**, **o**, **c** and **k** in their yellow books.
