What have we been learning?

- ◆ We have been reading the story of “**The Night Pirates**” & we really enjoyed hearing that it was the “rough, tough little girl pirates” who outwitted the grown up pirates!
- ◆ In our Phonics sessions this week we have been beginning to read words with five sounds (twist, trust, crunch) and we are also working hard to recognise our new set of “tricky words” onsite.
- ◆ In Maths we have been learning to write the number 11 correctly with the help of “**Episode 11**” from the “Tia Ten Show” on Ten Town. We have also been learning that the number 11 is made up of 10 and 1 more (Tia Ten and King One) not 2x 1s, because that would be 2 not 11.
- ◆ We have been using the small world Happyland figures to help us to role play what will be happening on Saturday at King Charles’ Coronation. We have also coloured in Union Jack flags and decorated crowns.

We absolutely loved going to Year 5’s classroom to meet Mrs Wells’ chicks on Wednesday afternoon!
